



Sport Funding 2015–16

We received a total of £3,835 in April 2015 and a further £5,384 in October 2015. This funding has gone towards:

- Minibus training – One of our biggest issues to get children participating in sports off site is the need to transport them to away venues. Parents who work often have to take time off to provide transport. To be able to transport these children enables more pupils to participate. At present we have one member of staff who is trained and able to drive a hired mini bus. Three other members of staff are in the process of being trained.
- Registration fees for an approved PE planning and assessment web site, which will provide a more robust system for PE in school.
- Supply cover cost to enable members of staff to take children to sporting events.
- Supply cover cost to enable staff to attend training courses to improve confidence in teaching PE or learning new skills.
- Continuing to get all pupils involved in sport with the introduction of new clubs such as kurling, taekwando and gymnastics.

In 2013/2014 the DfE gave us special permission to use our Sports funding to completely refurbish the field. However the funding does not cover the maintenance of the field and this is a concern as we need to be able to ensure it is regularly maintained. It should be noted that all the Wokingham football league matches have been played on our field this year due to the poor state of other schools fields.
