

Year 6 Leavers Survey 2014-15

The Survey was conducted anonymously. It was undertaken in the IT suite under the supervision of adults who were not directly linked to the year group. This decision was made with the aim to increase the likelihood of children giving honest answers as this removed the chance of their class teacher seeing their responses. If any child requested help, every effort was made not to influence their answer but only to enable them to understand the questions and express their opinion.

This year group was made up of 59 pupils [54% girls 46% boys]. 48 of these children came directly from the Infants School and 11 of them joined in later years. We asked the children for their feedback on the curriculum, teaching, homework, behaviour, safety and care at Oaklands. We also sought their opinions on changes and improvements that they might recommend for the future.

Here are some of the important things they had to tell us, which the staff can use to guide and shape their future plans.

When asked to name their favourite lesson the results were as follows:

When asked if they felt safe in school, only one child expressed any concern and that was in relation to PE equipment. All the other children said that they felt safe because:

All the teachers are happy to help and care about you if you're hurt or depressed

We have school gates

There are no bullies

The computers are safe from bad things

97% of children felt confident that they knew who they could speak to in school if they had any concerns or worries.

The majority of children thought the amount of homework they were given was 'just right', 3 thought there was not enough, 9 thought there was too much.

52 of the 59 children felt confident in knowing what their targets were and knew how to improve. Those who were not sure of their targets were less able to know how to improve.

81% of children thought that pupils behaved well at the school. The majority of 'late entry' children responded positively to this question.

When asked what they would like to change or improve at Oaklands the outstanding issue was School Meals. They would also welcome more Clubs and water fountains in the playground.

For most children their Best Experience whilst at Oaklands was the residential trip to Osmington Bay.

Finally they were asked to write one phrase or sentence to sum up their time at Oaklands Junior School and these are their responses:
