Safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children is defined as: protecting children from maltreatment; preventing impairment of children's health or development; ensuring that children grow up in circumstances consistent with the provision of safe and effective care; and taking action to enable all children to have the best outcomes.

Safeguarding Response

Manage Internally

One off incidents which the school believes that the child(ren) are not in need of early help or statutory intervention

Early Help

Non-violent harmful sexual behaviours

Refer to Social Care

All incidents where a child has been harmed, is at risk of harm or is in immediate danger

Refer to Police

All incidents of more serious assault

Safeguard and support victim and (alleged) perpetrator
