Our Family Workers work with and provide support to local families with in the centre or in the home. This individual and tailored support can be accessed by familes who:

- May like to know what's going on in the local area but are unsure or do not feel confident to find out what is happening.
- May like to meet other parents and join in with the activities and services but feel shy or unable to go alone.
- Feel lonely and isolated in the community or have little or no family support.
- Are having difficulties with everyday activities such as budgeting or healthy eating.
- Need a pre-school or childcare place but lack information or feel unsure about how to get a place.
- Are struggling with the physical and emotional demands of their child or children.
- Would like help with parenting skills such as setting boundaries or difficulties with behaviour etc.
- Have an illness or bereavement in the family which they are struggling to cope with.
- Have a child with additional needs.
- Or just need someone to talk to.
