Y6 SATs 2018

With government tests fast approaching (week commencing Monday 14th May), we would like to reassure parents and their children that these are just a snapshot of what children achieve in their time at Oaklands Junior School and sometimes, through anxiety, illness, family circumstances, lack of sleep or myriad other reasons, children do not always achieve as well as hoped for or expected. Please reassure your child, as we will, that this is not the end of the world and although we are judged as a school on these results in 'league tables' when they are published later in the year, we would like children to approach these tests as calmly as possible, knowing that they have worked hard and tried their best.

Our results for the last academic year were not as good as we would have liked, as can be the case when targets are aspirational or when the government change tests so that there is no longer any additional challenge (as previously in Level 6 papers) for the most able to achieve even greater progress. We still have writing as a focus for improvement and to this end, we introduced many new measures at the beginning of this academic year. GPS (Grammar, Punctuation & Spelling) can make all the difference to working at expected standard when every mark counts, so this has been a greater focus for all year groups this year. As a school, we have moderated writing through termly SLT book monitoring, regular staff moderation in staff meetings and with other schools. A cluster staff meeting also enabled us to look more widely across our local schools, sharing examples of writing, with standards achieved. We are confident that the measures we have in place will improve our writing in the long term and produce independent writers who are well equipped for their future.
