Easter Egg Competition **50 Years since the First Moon Landing (Eggs –Tra-Terrestrials)**

It is our tradition to set a competition for the children to create a shoebox-sized scene. This involves either blown eggs or any 'egg shapes' that could be made from polystyrene, wood, paper-maché or any other suitable material – the choice is theirs. The most important part is that the scene represents anything to do with the First Moon Landing, which took place 50 years ago when Apollo 11 landed on the moon, 16 Jul 1969 – 24 Jul 1969.

The children have been made aware of the competition and entries should be brought into school the week commencing Monday 1st April. Judging will take place at the end of the day on Tuesday 2nd April. Classes will have an opportunity to see all the entries and parents are invited to see the display in the library after school on Wednesday 3rd April.

All entries must be named, and include the class, as well as a title of the scene. Some children have asked if they can create an entry with a friend or in a group, which will be fine but if they win, they will need to share their Easter egg! There will be a main prize for the winner in each year group and a runner up prize. All entries will receive a small chocolate mini egg or Haribo sweet.
