# What are laws?

Laws are rules that are made by people in power to order the way society behaves.





### In the UK, power is split between three groups:

#### Parliament



### Makes and changes laws

#### The Government



Puts laws into practice and makes policy

#### The Justice System





## The rule of law

The rule of law means that the Government cannot do whatever it likes.

#### For example:

The Government cannot send people to prison.

The Government cannot take money from the people to make themselves rich.







### Why do we need laws?


- To keep us safe.
- To make sure things are fair.
- To limit the power of the Government.

# The police

An organised force that maintains order, preventing and detecting crimes and enforcing laws.





# A person who oversees a court of law and decides on sentencing.





### Someone who is qualified to advise on legal matters and represent people in court.





### Parliament

A group of elected and appointed people who make and change laws in the House of Commons and the House of Lords.





### The Queen

#### The Head of State. This person gives royal assent to any new laws.

For example, a person must wear a seatbelt when in a car.
