In order to be ready to open today, we are pleased to share with you that our Health & Safety inspection on Friday morning confirmed that we are doing everything we possibly can to ensure we have a safe school. A Health & Safety adviser from Bracknell Forest visited our school, along with two of our governors and the CEO of Corvus Trust. Our Risk Assessment was looked at in detail and there was a tour of the school to check measures already in place. During the afternoon, we had an online Local Governing Body meeting to discuss all that is in place and to approve our school opening for Y6. A further visit from Health & Safety will take place on Thursday when pupils are in school, to check how our procedures are working.

Our Risk Assessment is now on our website under the tab 'School Information' within the folder 'Covid 19 School Wider Opening Information'. Within this folder we have also included all our FAQs. Whilst writing, I would like to draw your attention to a few new questions at the end of this document that have now been added e.g. What happens if my child's teacher becomes ill and is off school?
