Oxford Owl eBook Library

In order to support your child's reading at home during this period of partial school closures, we have subscribed to the full juniors e-book library through Oxford Owl. Currently we have access to the free library which has some books available, but we will now be able to provide many more titles for pupils that are matched to their coloured book band (if they are on the reading scheme) or their reading age if they are a 'free reader'.

Continuing to read books at the appropriate level is particularly important for their continued progress in reading fluency and comprehension and so we are pleased to be able to offer this resource for our families.

To log in, please follow these instructions:

1. Go to www.oxfordowl.co.uk.
2. In the **Oxford Owl for Schools** section click 'Log in'.
