Local Election – Polling Station

Talks featured on perhaps one school being open and the others closed but this would not solve our site security or safeguarding issues. It would also put our families with infant and junior children at a disadvantage. Therefore it is looking like we will need to close on **Thursday 6th May** but we will be looking to create a day of home learning with activities for the children based on Democracy/British Values – more details will follow nearer the time.
