

Kendrick School Admissions

Good afternoon, Kendrick School has made some changes to their admission policies for 2024 entry and, in line with admission guidelines, we are now consulting on these policies.

The key changes are as follows:

Year 7

- Removal of some postcodes in Priority Area 2

Year 12

- Removal of some postcodes in Priority Area 2
- Change to the oversubscription criteria to:
 - Category 1 – Children in care or previously in care
 - Category 2 – applicants in receipt of pupil premium or service premium with a permanent home address in Priority Area 1 or Priority Area 2
 - Category 3 – applicants with a permanent home address in Priority Area 1 or Priority Area 2
 - Category 4 – candidates with a permanent home address not in the designated area
- Change of entry requirements:
 - Biology, Chemistry, Physics and Mathematics from a Grade 6 to Grade 7
 - Further Mathematics from Grade 7 to Grade 8

Non Routine

- Removal of some postcodes in Priority Area 2

The consultation must last for a minimum of 6 weeks and will commence on **Monday 7th November 2022**.
