

Consultation on proposed Admission Arrangements for Great Hollands Primary School for entry into Reception from September 2026

Introduction

Great Hollands Primary School is an academy school. Maiden Erlegh Trust is the admission authority for the school. When an admission authority wishes to make changes to their admission arrangements, they must consult to ensure all views are heard. We are proposing to amend the admission arrangements for Great Hollands Primary School to reduce the Published Admission Number (PAN),

Proposed changes to the oversubscribed criteria:

Proposed change to reduce the Published Admission Number (PAN) from 60 to 30

Why are we proposing these changes?

There is a surplus of places in the area and the school has seen a fall in their roll. A reduction in PAN will help the governing body provide stability in their long-term planning, including both the set-up of the school and budget planning.

What happens next?

After the consultation closes the responses will be collated and presented to the Admissions Committee at Maiden Erlegh Trust who will decide whether or not to proceed with the proposed changes and determine the admission arrangements. The outcome will be published on the school's website by 15 March 2025.
