## Open Morning for Parents/Carers – Wednesday 12th March

I am writing to invite you to our Open Morning at Oaklands Junior School on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> March 2025 and hope that you will be able to visit during that morning, anytime between 9.00am and 12.00pm. I hope this will provide you with an opportunity to see our school, particularly if your children might be joining us next September.

On arrival, if before 9am, please come to the hall via the playground, sign in and take a visitor's sticker to wear. Any visitors after 9am should enter via the Butler Road gate only and sign in at the main office. When leaving, we ask all parents to sign out at the main reception area and exit via the Butler Road gate only. This is to ensure the safeguarding of all our children at Oaklands' schools. A link to an electronic 'Comments' form, about your visit, will be sent to all parents/carers of children who attend.

The day will begin with a briefing in the hall to agree expectations for the morning. Although you may be inclined to spend your time entirely in your child's class, you are most welcome to visit all year groups in order to see a variety of lessons, progression and teaching styles within the school.
