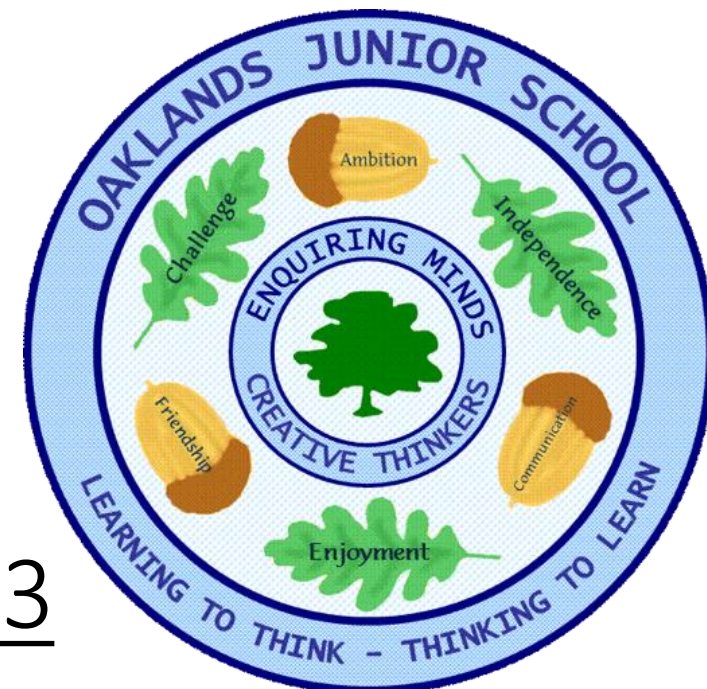

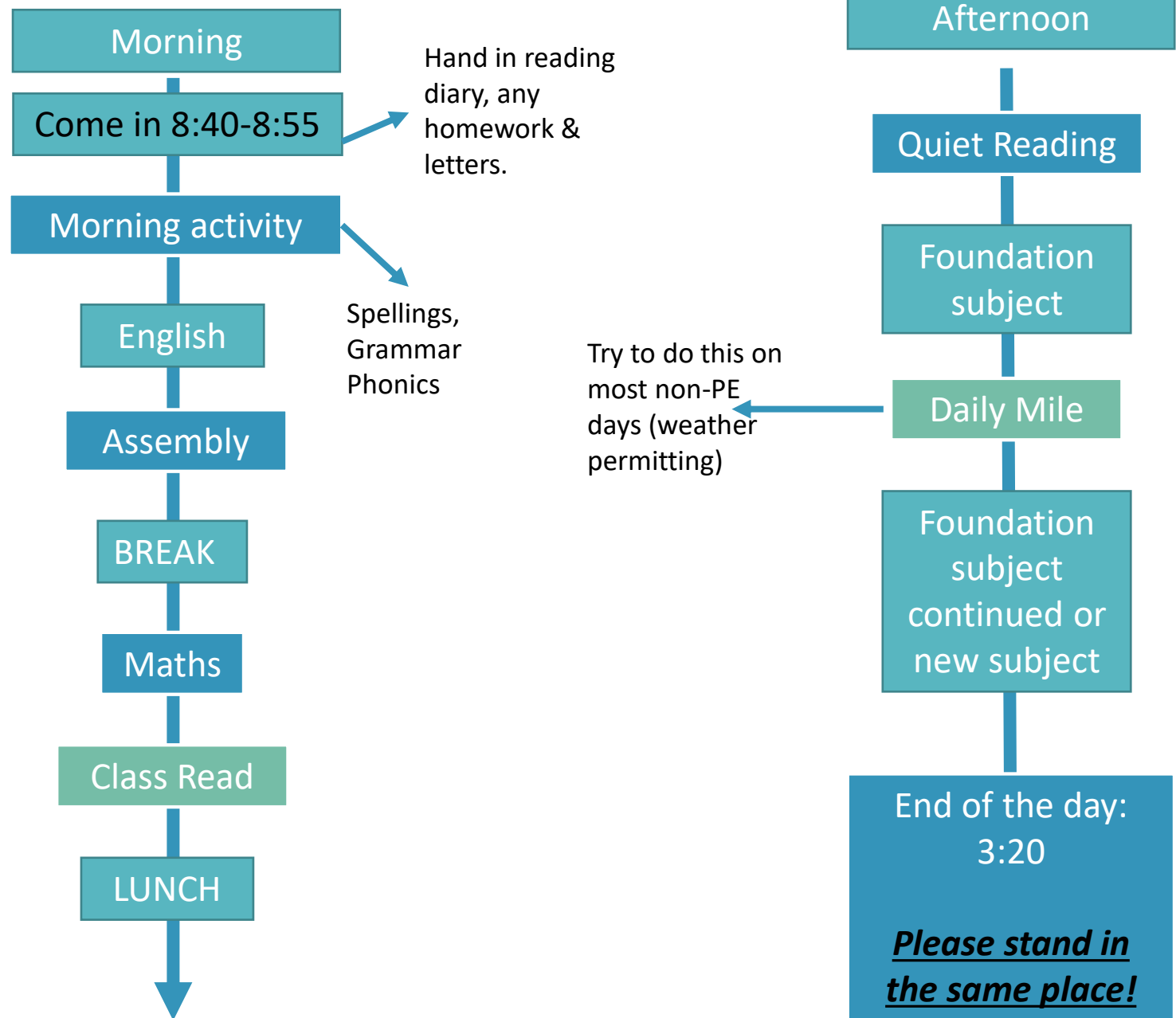

A typical day at Oaklands Junior School



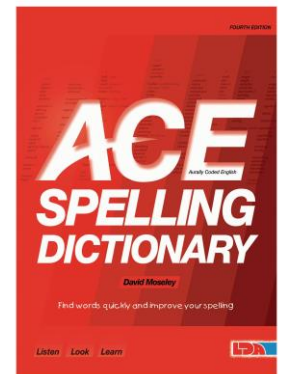
Today, we will battle Macbeth: a tyrannical monarch
